- earlier this week I wrote to the Director of Catholic Education to initiate bargaining for new Enterprise Agreements in the Federal Industrial arena, under the **Fair Work Act**.
- Dr Sayce responded positively; she wrote to say that CEWA is keen to commence negotiations in the near future.

Bargaining will shortly start and the results will affect EVERY employee in Catholic Education.

The challenge for union members and negotiators is to:

- retain the best aspects of the WA Registered Enterprise Agreements, i.e. not lose good conditions


- *negotiate new conditions that recognise increasing workloads and work intensification.*


